As a result, we will:

- Adopt the highest environmental standards in all areas of operation to ensure we meet or exceed all relevant legislative requirements.
- Minimise waste through efficient use or recycling of all materials and inputs.
- Minimise Energy Use through 'Turing Off' all electronic equipment when not in use and ensuring temperature control utilizes natural ventilation when possible or setting the Air Conditioning to 24oC.
- Only use sustainable or recycled products where possible: For Example, recycled toner cartridges, recycled packaging materials, etc.
- Provide environmental training and education to all employees.
- Encourage employee involvement.
- Reduce risks from environmental, health or safety hazards for employees and others in the vicinity of our operations.
- Adopt an environmentally sound transport strategy.
- Include environmental consideration in all investment decisions.
- Continually assess the environmental impact of all operations.
